Navagraha Murti location pros-cons

Navagraha, Padmavati and Satyanaraya Murti Sthapana Options with Pros-Cons

Option A: Navgraha +Padmavatiji +Satyanarayanji in a space that combines old Priest room and current Restrooms. Make new restrooms next to Annapurna Hall

- + In SW Corner per Vastu requirements
- + All three murtis in an independent room
- + Additional prayer hall
- + Out of the way of future entrance, in right location
- + Existing God's prep room can be used as is
- + Removes restroom from main building
- Satyanarayanji and Padmavatiji murtis need to be a more prominent position than Navagraha and not next to them.
- No Priest in new room all the time for performing puja or security
- New puja room is separate from main hall smaller space for devotees to sit down during pujas for Padmavatiji/ Satyanarayana.
- Access to new restrooms is inconvenient, specially for older/ handicapped devotees and during inclement weather
- Uses up one room that can be used for other activities (office, visitors, storage, second priest room)
- Large Scope (move restroom, break up walls etc.)
- Construction permit needed
- Highest Cost ~\$150K
- Long term project (8 to 12 weeks construction time + time needed to collect funds)
- Devotees objecting to murti/ prayer hall in the location of former rest room

Option B: Navgraha in old kitchen/ current puja prep room +Padmavati+Satyanarayanji main prayer hall with their positions swapped (Padmavati can face South and Satyanarayanji will face North)

- + In SW Corner per Vastu requirements
- + All murtis in main hall
- + Main Hall can be used for all puja
- + Out of the way of future entrance, in right location
- + Existing old priest room can be used for office, visitors, storage, second priest room
- + Independent place for Navagraha puja
- + No Construction permit needed
- + Smallest scope of work among 3 options
- + Lowest Cost ~15K can be covered with existing funds in Temple account
- + Project can be completed in 2-3 weeks
- + No restroom or sewer line issue
- God's prep room is needed (can be made in corner of Navagraha location)
- Room shares common wall with Restrooms, as does current puja hall
